The resurrection, is it a historical fact or a legend that grew over the years? Last week I went to the Socratic Club debate about this. One thing I found interesting was the skeptic's focus on Joseph of Arimathea. Joseph goes to Pilate to ask for the body of Jesus and then puts it in a tomb. The skeptic suggests that a fear of death would keep Joseph, a respected member of the Sanhedrin, from asking Pilate for the body. Yet, if Joseph was rich enough to own a tomb, high up in the Sanhedrin, and believed Deuteronomy 21:22-23, he would have been able to influence Pilate to give him Jesus' body for burial before Passover began to ensure peace. It was a fascinating debate that challenged me to reread the gospels and consider again how the resurrection accounts work together in creating a full picture while focusing on the audience and intention for their specific gospel.
