PRAYER THEMES for this week:

Monday, March 31: Jesus wept over Jerusalem as he realized they had missed the opportunity to experience peace. Pray that the gospel of peace will be heard and understood by more and more people in our towns.

Tuesday, April 1: Things do go wrong in relationships. Pray for a spirit of forgiveness to permeate our lives and lives of the people around us. Pray for restoration of broken relationships.

GIVING OPPORTUNITY:

It's always great to witness the way the congregation responds to needs around the world. We have a history of blessing Orphans, Hurricane victims; and people in Ghana, West Africa who were in need of clean water. In the years following that mercy mission, Churches of Christ have had a significant impact in Ghana.

Now we have the **opportunity to participate in good work for East Africa**. An area suffering from a 6 year long drought.

Sunday, March 16, we gave \$4,827.02, which is **\$427.02 above our \$4,400 weekly needs budget**. That is a **great start on our gift** that will be sent for drilling wells in East Africa and opening doors for the gospel.

Last week, the Spring break travel impacted us significantly and we did not exceed the \$4,400 target. But that's no reason to end the challenge or slack back on this important effort. **The gift to be sent can still be increased.**

We have two more weeks left in this important challenge of giving: March 30 and April 6. We are reaching for \$4,600 each week. **Offering above the \$4,400 budget will enlarge the gift we can send away.**

Remember: Every gift you offer is a guaranteed success in bringing glory to God and prompting prayers of thanks. Even the **\$427 already set to be sent** to this mission of mercy will make a difference. Every gift we give is **already a success.**
