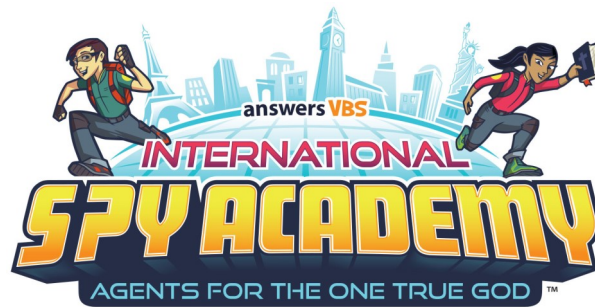

Gregg's Good News

I heard a radio interview earlier today with Paul Jacobs. He is an organ player who is performing as part of the Oregon Bach Festival.

One expects to hear a discussion of the music he will be performing; and other aspects of the performer's life. After all, the primary purpose of the interview is to invite radio listeners to the organist's live performances.

The conversation turned to the reality that churches are the most common venue for organs to be built and played. The interviewer wondered if that was one reason for a decrease in the number of

students of the instrument and implied that may also explain a decreased interest in listening to organ performances.

Mr. Jacobs then launched into an unexpected area by proclaiming, "There is a spiritual core to every human being." He mentioned a problematic reality of our culture: over the top busyness that is driven by materialism. As a result, people are so fixated on the tangible that they overlook the spiritual. Paul Jacobs declared that every person needs to invest time considering the "meaning of life, good and evil." Every human should wrestle with the question "does God exist."

I found the man's comments a refreshing declaration of truth. From his viewpoint, he was arguing in favor of music and the arts because they speak to the heart. Yet foundational

to his belief was the necessity of every person exploring "the bigger questions."

During our "Every Member on Mission" study of Acts, we have contemplated how to invite this generation to engage the topic of God, church, Christ and life. It seems to me that Mr. Jacobs gave us one very helpful example of how to bring the topic to the forefront.

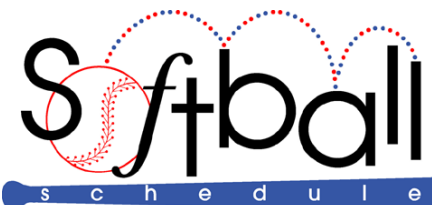
