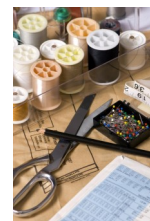
Help us keep our bathrooms functioning:

Our sewer is aging and our bathrooms are in the basement. The builders were not able to have the sewer pipes start at a high enough elevation for the slope to assist drainage to the street. The aging pipes are getting rough and this will continue to slow paper products. We ask that you do not put anything in the toilets except *necessary* toilet paper and the seat covers. Flushing twice would help as it will add more water to the system and assist delivery to the city lines. Our options to fix the line include putting in a new pipe (smoother = better flow) or running a new line possibly to Circle instead of Kings, both of which would be very expensive. At this point we understand the problem and we think if we all work together we can avoid major construction.

November 2: Special Collection for Building Entrance Remodeling Project

For several years now it has been apparent that we needed to replace the overhang on the south entrance of the building. The Elders have been leading an effort to come up with a plan to replace the overhang and to improve overall access to the building. With the help of Bob Parsons and Powell construction we have arrived at a plan that will meet our objectives. [If you would like to see the plans, there are 3 copies in Room 6 of the Education Wing.] We received an initial bid of \$54,000 for this project. However, by removing some items and offering to provide the labor to remove the old overhang and the steps, we now have a bid of \$42,000. This is still a lot of money! Please understand that our building is aging and from time to time we need to make repairs and improvements. We have funds on hand to cover most of this project, but we would like to ask the congregation to consider providing additional funds to help pay for this project and so as not to deplete our reserves. Currently, the plan is to do this remodel in the spring of 2015. It will take about 6 weeks to complete. We hope to raise between \$5,000 and \$10,000, or even more, between now and then through special contributions. Please be praying about what you can do. On Sunday, November 2 we will have a special contribution to provide funds for the remodel. The results will determine the need for possible additional offerings. Thank you for your thoughtful consideration of this request.
