Gregg's Good News

The beginning of school often correlates with people looking for a church. **If you are a guest today, welcome!** Please accept our invitation to **join us for lunch** after the assembly finishes. Our aim is to create a situation where you can get to know a few church members and we can welcome you.

The news in recent days has included several items with "religious" overtones. The Pope has been widely covered as he travels to Washington, DC and the Eastern United States. Presidential hopeful Ben Carson has been chastised for voicing the opinion that he would not like to see a Muslim in the White House. Meanwhile, refugees flee the Mid-East with some bringing reports that the Radical Islamic group ISIS behaves like the Mafia.

In the midst of that news, remember again the ultimate "religious" good news presented by God at I Cor. 15: 1-5.

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. ²By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. ³For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve.

Some people overlook a significant portion of the good news message. Once God welcomes us in forgiveness, the good news continues. With a fresh start, a person is prepared to grow beyond failings of the past and be a new person. One who is making better choices and living a holy life. Resurrection to new life *is* good news.
