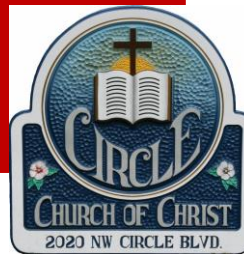

The message of creation is so clear that Rom. 1: 20 suggests no one who observes what is tangible should miss the facts of God's eternal power and divine nature.
