The beginning of school often correlates with people looking for a church. **If you are a guest today, welcome!** Please accept our invitation to **join us for lunch** after the assembly finishes. Our aim is to create a situation where you can get to know a few church members and we can welcome you.

Mentoring is a practice that is commonly depicted on the pages of the Bible. Moses trains Joshua before Israel enters the Promised Land. Moses knows it is Joshua who will lead God's people in the future to a land where Moses is not allowed to go.

Jesus trains the 12 apostles and several other unnamed disciples who are sent out to preach and heal while Jesus is present. Yet Jesus knows that those who have been trained and will be trained are the ones who will take the gospel to the far flung corners of the world.

Paul trains Timothy and charges him to entrust God's word to other faithful Christians. Paul knows that the end of his life is approaching and getting the gospel to future generations will depend on a group larger than just one man.

Some of you are in the process of mentoring other disciples. Getting plans started to mentor people in various other skills is still a work in progress. It's not feasible to start everything at once. So be quick to mentor and receive mentoring as each new aspect of this effort is rolled out. The newest effort is mentoring in Scripture study and Prayer.
