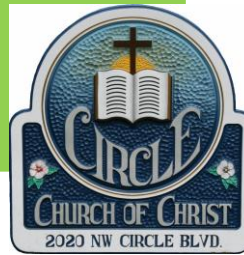

# Gregg's Good News

Long ago, I would hear people mention an idea from I Cor. 1:10: "perfectly united in mind and thought."

The context of I Cor. centers in a church that is suffering division for numerous reasons. Who baptized a person was being held up as a reason for personal pride. Who one prized as a teacher was becoming a point of difference. Lawsuits between church members were occurring. Sexual immorality was tolerated by some. Differences about matters of personal opinion were stretching the fabric of the congregation. As the church assembled for the Lord's Supper, some people would not even wait for others. People were being evaluated on the basis of how they expressed God's giftedness. And convictions as core as resurrection were misunderstood.

As we read through that list, it becomes apparent that every one of them reflects a misunderstanding of monumental proportions. The unity in Corinth is being disturbed by differences concerning fundamentally profound truths. Commands as crucial as love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength and love your neighbor as yourself were being violated.

When some people would talk about the idea of "perfectly united in mind and thought," they boiled it down to every church member thinking exactly the same thing about every tiny nuance of Scripture, life together in the church and 24/7 behavior of Christians. Strangely, the ultimate outcome was disunity. Any disagreement about any minute detail was cause for alarm and argument. Paul's solution to the disunity in Corinth is not forcing unanimity in every detail. Instead, he returns to the core: Jesus died for our sins, was buried and was raised. As we keep our unity emphasis on big picture essentials, it leaves room for appropriate freedom and eliminates much of the friction that comes from individual differences.
