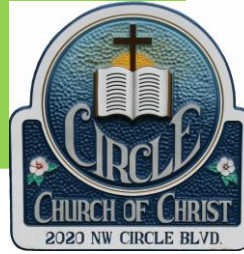

As always, helpers are needed for the various tasks. I'm sure you can find something that fits your abilities and time schedule. I will be teaching the Adult class that meets on Wednesday nights during the children's VBC time.

Beginning this Sunday evening, I plan to begin looking at some moments in Paul's life. I am hoping that will help parents have additional insights to share with their children at home. People who are teachers may also find a "leg up" as they begin preparation for the topic they will be covering.

Remember: Summer nights on Wednesday are not just for kids! There are ample service and learning opportunities for all ages.



Speaking of Paul, it is interesting to learn from his mission methods. He was very aware of differences in people he encountered in different regions of the Greco-Roman world.

In light of those differences, he would look for people at various places. Sometimes he was teaching at a synagogue. Other times it was the public discussion place of Athens. He taught one woman by the riverside.

What if the contemporary church imitated the first century apostle and went to where other people were? What if Christians intentionally gathered in a public place to sing and share a meal? What if people of God sought to mix with neighbors on their neighbors' turf? *More to come in the weeks ahead.*
