# Gregg's Good News

People told us that the Olympic Peninsula of Washington was beautiful. Our recent visit to that area confirmed those statements. In addition, the travel provided several reminders of the wonder of our Father.

One day, the hike led us to a glacier fed river the color of an Opal stone. Later, we crossed a creek with plants growing just beneath the water that were an indescribable color of yellow-green with a design like silken hair. I would return to that bridge time and again to chat with God if that waterway was nearby.

In Forks, Washington we encountered a large contingent of women. The annual "Twilight" festival occurred last weekend. The women were present to seek sights related to the vampire and his lovely girlfriend, "Bella." (Ask a young woman if you don't know these books and movies.) I pray that the women's interest in the "other-worldly" will one day lead them to seek the true and living God.

We were instructed to make sure we travelled to Hurricane Ridge. The drive up goes from sea level to some 5,000 feet. The vista included a remarkable view of Mt. Olympus. During our picnic lunch, I spoke with people from Wyoming. Perhaps it was the mention of church ministry, but for whatever reason— as they left, one of the women said, "We were just talking about, 'How could anyone see this sight and not believe in God?'"

Sunday, we enjoyed assembling with the church in Sequim. The Lord was the focus. Yet the addition of visitors added encouragement to a predominantly retired group meeting at the American Legion hall. (I concur with Casey: When travelling, stop in and bless the church wherever you are.)

In the midst of travels, a chat with a German couple included the opportunity to offer them hospitality and a paper invitation to the church website. Chats with the museum hosts and a salmon fisherman allowed time to mention church. Few words were spoken, but spoken with the hope that perhaps the small mention would help them *also* see God in the beauty of His creation.
