## Gregg's Good News

On Tuesday I attended a continuing education event for people in full time ministry. One of the speakers highlighted "teaching people to pray" as a top priority.

In the Life groups I have led for the past 6-7 years, an emphasis has been on everyone learning to pray. When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray, he gave them a model of words to use and then expected them to pray.

In my experience, the most effective way to learn to pray is "learning by doing." So, consider the topics that follow and tell God what you think about them. You will be praying.

*For the next few weeks, I plan to offer several points of prayer that we can unite in on various days of the week.*

**Monday:** Pray for all candidates for public office to seek what God defines as moral, honorable and just.

**Tuesday:** Pray that the Gospel would be truly heard by all Americans. That people from every background would be drawn to Christ.

**Wednesday:** Pray for all the children and youth of America. That they would increase in godly desires and hope.

**Thursday:** Pray that the reign and rule of God would increase in your life and family.

**Friday:** Pray for a decrease in domestic violence and all forms of abuse.
