Ice on the parking lot this morning resulted in lots of empty spots. That reminded me to share with all of us the following thoughts I have gathered while listening to various members of the congregation.

1. Several members of our congregation have mobility impairments due to age or other constraints. If you are NOT one of those people, **please park farther away from the building and leave spots nearby for those with difficulty walking.** It is fine to park in the lot of the medical offices that connects to our parking lot.

2. The bathroom directly off the foyer is intended primarily for people with mobility impairments or conditions that result in urgent needs to use the restroom. Even if that bathroom is available, please go ahead and walk downstairs so that the **foyer bathroom is available for those who do not have other options.** Please also remind your children of this.

3. Teach your **children to exercise caution about running near older folks.** A simple fall for an aged person can result in a broken hip or other difficulties.

Do not hear this as a "cranky rule list." The fact is, we just need reminders sometimes about how to live together well in this extended family of brothers and sisters called the church. ☺
