As you walked through the Ministry Fair last Sunday, I trust you were encouraged by the diverse collection of tasks that we undertake as a congregation. In addition, I hope that it was a good reminder that everyone is welcome to serve in the life of this church. And if you haven't found your task yet, it's not too late. Give a Ministry Leader a call and express your interest.

A giant **THANK YOU to Loretta Hartman** for creativity in planning and follow through in set-up for the event. Thanks to all the **Ministry Leaders** who staffed the tables to talk about their efforts. And **Teens** as well as **Teen Parents** did a good job of entertaining children so parents could explore the exhibits. **Well done, everyone.**

Last week I wrote a reminder for all of us to **do two things as we assemble to worship.**

1. Expect to meet with God.
2. Listen for the theme that is threaded through the Scripture reading, songs and the sermon.

One thing that will help all of us move in those directions begins with the decision to **view the word "worship" as a verb.** For those who haven't set foot in English class for a while, verbs are action words.

If you look around the room, you might see a person who "comes to church," sits down and waits for the people on the stage to do and say the right things so that person can "worship." This is often the person who is frustrated if the songs weren't to their liking or the sermon said more to someone else.

In contrast, worship as a verb lays the responsibility on each person who is present.

When you **offer your voice** to God in song, **your heart** to God in communion, **and your mind** to God for His teaching—you quickly discover that the assembly is richer than it ever was before.
