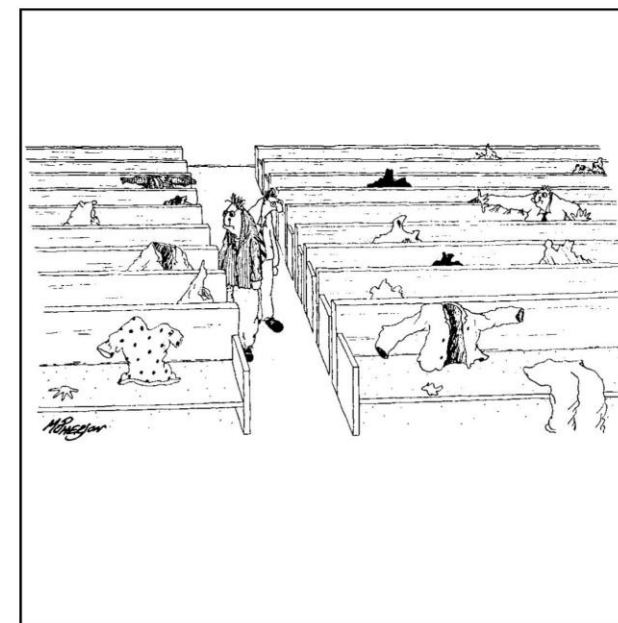

# Gregg's Good News

If you are a guest at church today after coming to shop at our Clothing Giveaway—Welcome! It would be wonderful if you joined us every Sunday as we honor God and encourage one another.

A gift of clothes is a good gift. But this church would be doing less than we should if we only gave a gift of clothes. We exist to offer a bigger gift—a relationship with God himself. Consider some of the important things that can be accomplished by words.

The Bible begins with the account of God speaking words. As a result, creation comes into being. And as God creates item after item, the refrain is pronounced, "And it was good." Ultimately, God creates humanity. Gen. 1:31 concludes by saying, "God saw all that he had made, and it was very good."

Some readers have experienced the toughness of life and heard words that lead them to believe they are not good; rather they are valueless. If that describes you, reclaim the truth God proclaimed long ago. If he created you, you have value in His sight.

Words are also powerful when it comes to entering a relationship with God. "Faith comes from hearing the message and the message is heard through the word of Christ." (Rom. 10:17) A few verses earlier, emphasis is placed on words a person of faith confesses, "Jesus is Lord." Only 3 words, but they communicate a revolution of the heart. Jesus, not self, is now my God, King and ultimate authority. And the words "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" pronounced over you as you are baptized/immersed in water coincide with being united with Christ.

You may have heard many words over the years of your life. But the message that a good God wants to make you good for each day of the future is nothing less than good news.
