# Gregg's Good News

Weather forecasters are predicting an extra rainy 4 days scheduled to finish up today, Sunday. Those of us who live in Oregon have come to recognize these seasons of tropical moisture as part of Winter here.

I'll be honest: I have also lived in areas of the U. S. where the Winter sky is still blue unless it is actively raining. So sometimes the series of days without seeing the sun in Corvallis wears on me and some of you.

Truly, the effects of the rain, including green forests and stunning waterfalls, are part of what gives our area the unique beauty we prize. Beyond that, when the Winter is too dry, we have concerns about the availability of water during the following Summer.

The point is more than viewing the rain in the same way we choose to view the glass as half full rather than half empty. The point is choosing to view what goes on with the weather as a work of God the Sustainer of His creation. Psalm 104:10-17 reveals that even something as seemingly common as rain is a purposeful act of God for the sake of His interdependent creation. He makes springs pour water into the ravines; it flows between the mountains. <sup>11</sup>They give water to all the beasts of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst. <sup>12</sup>The birds of the sky nest by the waters; they sing among the branches. <sup>13</sup>*He waters the mountains from his upper chambers; the land is satisfied by the fruit of his work.* <sup>14</sup>He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate—bringing forth food from the earth: <sup>15</sup>wine that gladdens human hearts, oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts. <sup>16</sup>The trees of the LORD are well watered, the cedars of Lebanon that he planted. <sup>17</sup>There the birds make their nests; the stork has its home in the junipers.

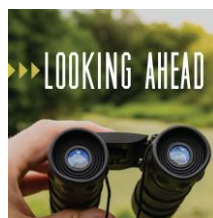

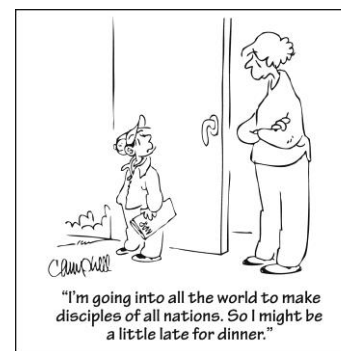
