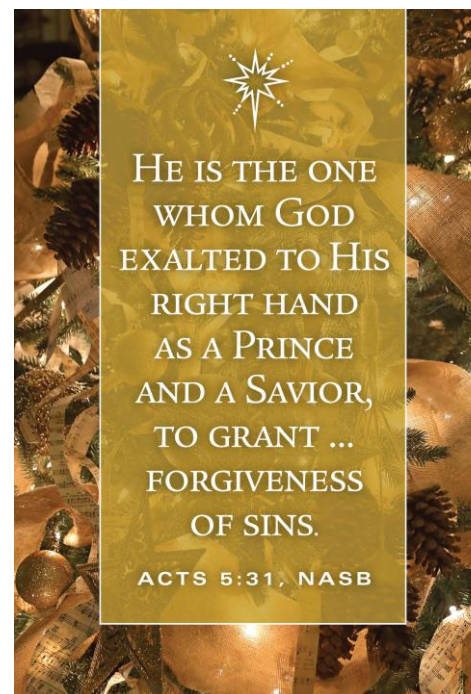

In the broad sweep of this art gallery called Earth, the Creator has awareness of me. My heart is smiling.

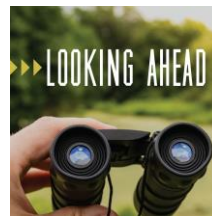
