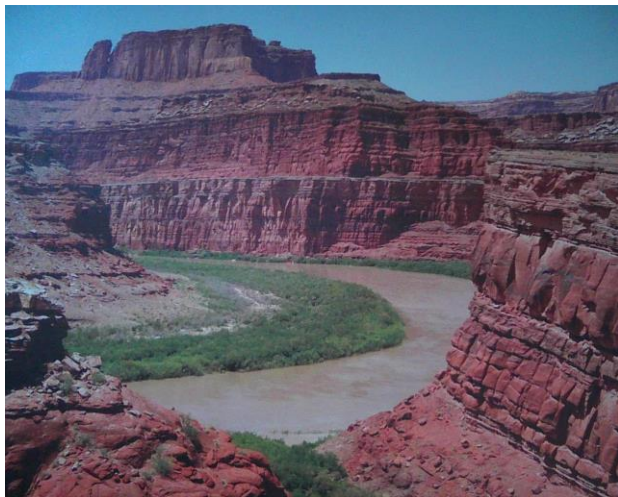

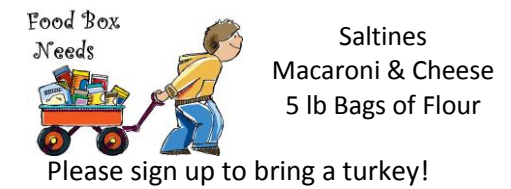

If you would like a **Thanksgiving Food Box**, please fill out a form on the kiosk and put in Charlene's mailbox (C. Franklund) **before November 12th**.



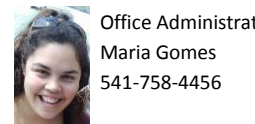
