A man is very serious. Clearly, his goal is to lead his family in paths of righteousness. He is an avid student of the Word and works to see congregations of the Lord's church throughout the state do very well. Consequently, sometimes he gets frustrated by decisions people with influence over the various congregations make—and he complains.

A woman is a single Mom. By Old Testament definition, her two children are "fatherless." In the Jewish world, they would have been thought of as "orphans." She works faithfully at her job and at ensuring that she and her children persist in seeking life with the church. Sometimes she feels a tinge of anger towards God. This is not the life she expected.

A woman recently received the diagnosis no one wants to hear: Cancer. She always envisioned the later years of life as a time to fully dedicate herself to Christian service. That would be the season of very actively exposing her children and grandchildren to the faith. "Why God?" finds its way into her prayers daily.

A man never feels peace. His God is a harsh taskmaster. At any moment, he fears God will be so upset with him, that God consigns him to hell. He became a Christian years ago and desires to walk in the light presently, but fear consistently holds sway.

Which one of these people does God love? Rom. 8 reminds us: Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? . . . ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
