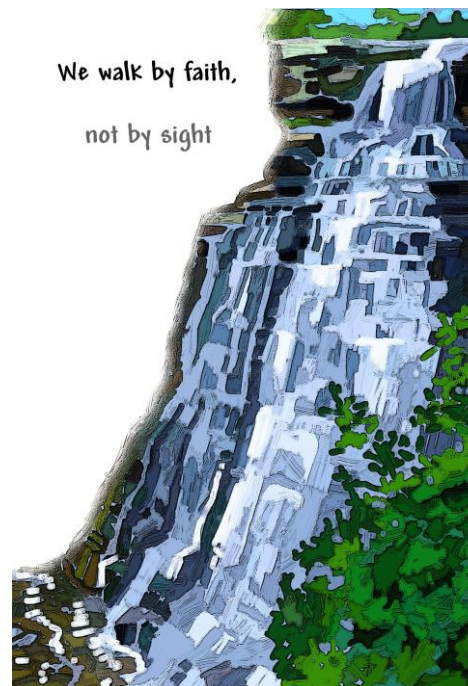

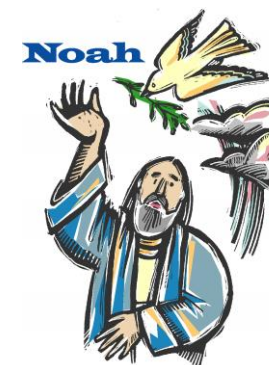

Gregg's Good News

"I won't believe it unless I see it with my own two eyes." You have likely heard a person make a statement like that. For that person, sensory experience is the test necessary to prove truth.

This morning, I am having an experience that demonstrates the fault in such an approach. When I look out the window to the NW, all I can see is an angry, black cloud. So, given what I "see with my own two eyes," at this moment, I would conclude nothing exists there but an ugly cloud.

In fact, about an hour and a half ago, the cloud was not visible in that location. Consequently, what I could see then was vastly different. The fact is, a tall hill exists behind those clouds. And the hillside was as beautiful to look at—with all the trees decked out in a dazzle of snow—as the black cloud is off putting.

If I told you there is a beautiful hillside behind the cloud, even though you can't see it, you would have to take my word on faith. If you want to see God "with your own eyes," and can't see Him, the alternative is listening to the witnesses who speak in Scripture and deciding by faith that the invisible God is still present in His world.

One more idea: What was visible about the hillside in the past is not visible to me now. Does that mean the hillside is no longer there? No, I trust the hillside has not moved away. As time goes on, what is visible often changes. A snowy hillside gives way to the sight of a black cloud. Just because God spoke to a few hand-picked people in the past, or Jesus and the first apostles did miraculous signs before the Scripture's witness was written down, does not mean a decrease in those visible events tells us God is no longer present. While we may see a difference in God's mode of operation as times change, it's not accurate to assume that God ceased to exist. Things look different at different moments, but faith allows us to know the invisible reality is still there.
