Gregg's Good News

The school shooting in Florida Wednesday increased the news peoples' chatter about "Why is this happening? What should be done to stop it?" Rhetoric about gun control, enhanced background checks, violent video games comes to the forefront. A few voices also ask about the state of assistance in the United States for people with mental illness.

Years of ministry in Corvallis provide me a small sense of the state of assistance for people in this area with some forms of mental illness. Years ago, efforts were made to move people out of the state hospital in Salem to community-based centers. Janus House in Corvallis was a place where several people with mental illness lived together. But within a few years, government funding began to go down. The number of homeless and/or street people with mental illness seemed to jump up. In my experience, many needy street people have a mental illness or challenge caused by drug use. That includes veterans.

Now I hear stories of an extreme shortage of Psychiatrists and long waits to see a prescriber in this community. That's the case for people who are functional on their own or are supported by family/friends who can assist. I'm unsure what transpires for those with mental illness without a support network other than people like me who sometimes take them to the E. R. or Benton County Mental Health.

I'm sure talk about "Why are there shootings?" will continue. Is one answer an increase in Christians choosing to serve in the arena of Mental Health? Perhaps as care-givers or policy makers in government? In the short run, I thank God for the work of Mialea Womack.
