Gregg's Good News

Some time ago there was a young woman who went to Africa to be a missionary. One day, she came across a small baptismal service. Another missionary took 3 new converts to the center of a shallow river, where he dug a hole in the sand so there would be enough water to baptize them.

The young missionary saw what she expected. Some friends and family members gathered to watch, the missionary in the river recited some familiar Scriptures, and baptized the first person. When the new convert came up out of the water, he was excited and began to shout joyfully. The second and third converts also came up from the shallow river shouting for joy.

The young missionary was curious. "Why all the shouting?" she asked the man who had done the baptizing. He replied, "I haven't been able to completely communicate in this tribe's native tongue. They didn't understand that the death they would undergo in baptism was symbolic. When I told them they would be buried with Christ through baptism into death and raised to walk in the newness of life, they thought baptism would kill them."

The man started chuckling, but the young woman's gaze stopped him. She asked, "If you thought baptism would kill you, would you be willing to get in the river?"

Romans 6 tells us that we **are** dead through baptism. We died with Christ and we believe that we will also live with him. Because of this, we need to count ourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. What sin in your life do you need to put to death this week?
