# Gregg's Good News

There is something especially poignant about the scene of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane when I read it in light of Jesus' humanity. I understand that Jesus knew what the next few days held, while the disciples didn't. But he asks clearly for assistance: "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me." There's something heartbreaking in the fact that upon his return, Jesus must ask the question "Could you not keep watch with me for one hour?"

This scene offers a glimpse into Jesus as God in flesh. The Son of God, who had enough power to raise Lazarus from the dead, wants friends alongside at this hour of despair.

When I observe our model, Jesus, reaching to friends at a difficult time, I recognize it reminds us to imitate his example. The habit of "going it alone" may be an aspect of Oregon culture. But Jesus shows us that Christian culture is not like that.

I am not immune to facing moments in life that are bigger than my own resources. So, I appreciate Jesus' example of reaching to friends to come alongside at moments like that. And I appreciate when God sends friends who listen well, empathize genuinely and continue in prayer. They don't have to tell me that. I know their character. Thank you.

You have friends who have invited you close at moments of concern. I'm just curious. Are you asleep or on watch?
