Gregg's Good News

Sunday evening as I left church, I noted that the sun was a vibrant orange color. Apparently, the smoke from forest fires has found its way to our skies. Shortly thereafter, I noticed my eyes were watery. By Monday, my voice had an edge of hoarseness in it.

Smoke has such effects on many human bodies. That makes me stop and wonder why smoking tobacco had so much appeal for so long. If an activity results in a cough and gravelly voice, it is a warning sign that your body isn't happy with the habit. We now understand that there are links between smoking, heart disease and cancer.

From an early age, I remember hearing I should avoid habits that are bad for my body. Why? "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body." (1 Cor. 6:19-20)

I do understand that once people start smoking, it is a difficult habit to break. I'm glad that it is a habit I never picked up. To those of you who see your friends vaping or smoking, I recommend "Don't Start."

It's good that I am not a smoker. But that doesn't mean it is OK for me to damage the temple of the Holy Spirit in other ways. At age 65, it is not easy to change eating habits, or the habits of insufficient exercise and failing to find sufficient rest. But maybe I'll be more successful if I view new habits as spiritual disciplines.

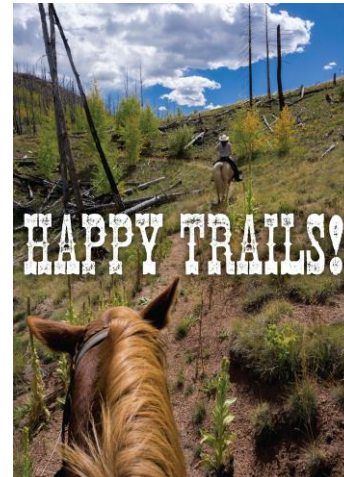
