# Gregg's Good News

John 11 depicts the scene of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead in Bethany. Many of the onlookers at that scene came to faith. Others went to Jerusalem and reported to the Pharisees what Jesus had done.

Jesus retreated with his disciples to the desert. So, the Jewish leadership ordered people to report if they knew where Jesus was. The leaders planned to arrest the miracle worker. John 12:9 reports that when a large crowd of Jews learned Jesus was again in Bethany, they came to see Jesus. And they also wanted to see Lazarus. Perhaps they too were seeking confirmation of Jesus' miracle and moving to faith in Him.

But the Jewish leadership had already conspired. Since the resurrection of Lazarus was inspiring many Jews to have faith in Jesus, the chief priests made plans to kill Lazarus as well.

*This is a striking development. Jesus could be accused of blasphemy. In the leaders' ears, they heard Jesus making himself equal with God. But what was the charge against Lazarus?*

There are moments in life when a group is so committed to achieving the outcome they desire, that obedience to the Law or even ethical decency is discarded. In this case, the chief priests are willing to end the life of an innocent man simply because he poses a threat to their stranglehold on power.
