Long before I knew I would spend my life serving in full-time ministry, I began leading Bible studies for college students. I drove to preach in Toledo, Oregon for about a year and a half. That probably started in 1978. Summer of 1980, I preached for Circle during a preacher search. School year 1980-1981 came with a couple opportunities to preach for small congregations in Texas. Throughout all of this, I did not realize that God was training me for a future I did not anticipate.

I started serving on staff with this congregation on August 1, 1981. During school year 1983-1984 I pursued my task of Campus Ministry and preached for the congregation on Sundays. Since that time, the bulk of my preaching experience has been with this congregation.

Given my commitment to preaching at Circle, I have not accepted every opportunity to preach elsewhere. But I very much prize the opportunities to do so. I always learn an immense amount that ultimately benefits my service with you.

Preaching to different congregations forces me to discover more ways to engage people from different backgrounds and mindsets. In new places, I learn to incorporate new images and vocabulary that crosses into the world of that group. I get opportunities to point to the unique ways this congregation and individual Christians are living to glorify God. Talks and meals with members is encouraging. And I always enjoy the reminder that God is alive and well in many corners of the globe.

So I bring you greetings from the Homer, Alaska Church of Christ. And I bring back more insight to God and His people—including you.

Now some reflections. The college group has been studying Tim Keller's *Prodigal God* (Luke 15:11-32). One of the major lessons we learned is that both sons in the parable of the prodigal son are lost at some point in the story. The younger son is initially lost because he is trying to control his father through rebellion. The older son is lost because he is trying to control his father through obedience. The younger is lost through trying to be very bad, and the older through being very good. The root of the problem is materialistic idolatry. They want their father's things, but not their father. Both sons are searching for satisfaction, meaning and rest in created things, not the love of their creator. What are you looking for satisfaction, meaning or rest? Is it a relationship with a person? Is it your career? Is it your hobbies? Is it popularity? Is it wealth, power, or fun? "Only in returning to me and resting in me will you be saved." (Isaiah 30:15).
