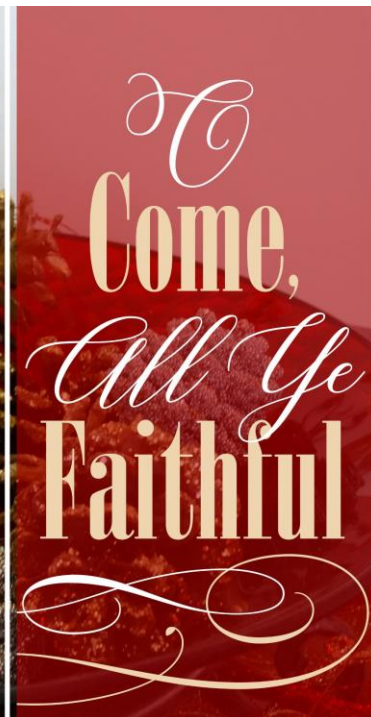

Gregg's Good News

I often wish that the many people around us who are unbelievers could come to grips with one single fact: Living as a believer is the path to blessing, not to a cursed life.

Here's what I mean. The image of Christian life many people internalize is that of an endless list of restrictions, rules and roadblocks to anything fun, pleasurable or recreational in life. They view life in fellowship with a church as just another way to be required to wear a pair of handcuffs.

How that unbalanced mindset became prevalent is not completely clear to me. It is true that the Bible calls us to avoid actions and habits that are contrary to the imitation of Christ. But one primary way the Bible calls us to flee evil is by the active pursuit of doing good. Repentance is about pursuing the good as much as it is about rejecting the bad.

These thoughts began as I encountered a single verse. Luke 1:45 records the statement Elizabeth made to Mary when the young virgin came for a visit and Elizabeth's unborn baby leapt for joy. "Blessed is she who has believed that what the Lord has said to her will be accomplished."

Blessing and belief clearly belong in the same sentence. "Lord, please infuse that thought into the hearts and minds of our unbelieving acquaintances."
