I spent this past week with my nuclear family, which includes by brother, Ben, his wife Rachel, my nephew Josiah (almost 2) and niece Anna (less than 1 year old). We spent many joyful moments laughing and pushing buttons. I was very impressed by my brother's sacrificial love for his son. On Sunday, Ben would go with Josiah during the sermon to care for him and aid the overworked children's ministry volunteers. He plans to continue this habit to ensure his son's spiritual growth and safety. It reminded me of this verse:

“People were bringing little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said to them, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these” (Mark 10:13-14). Children's spiritual growth is very important. Jesus doesn't get indignant very often, but he does get indignant with adults who are too cool for Sunday school. Children belong in the presence of Jesus. Here are two lessons for Circle:

- 1) If you hear a kid crying or making noise in church, praise God! That is the most beautiful sound in the universe.
- 2) If you are a parent, bring your kids to church and volunteer in the children's program. Investing in your children's spiritual growth will produce a “harvest of righteousness and peace”.
