Admission: \$5.00.

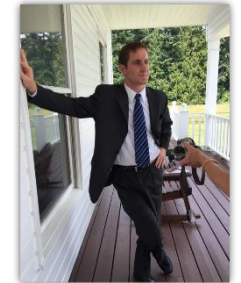
