Thomas' Thoughts On  
What Will The Answer Be?

"May I have this please?" my son asks. He asks wanting a certain answer, of course. We enjoy the "yes" answer. Yes to the dessert, to the toy, to the job, to the relationship, the list goes on. What we don't enjoy hearing are the other possible answers, even though they are just as valid.

1st John 5:14-15 tells us that God hears our prayers and will answer according to His will. This means that God answers our prayers according to what is best for us to become more like Christ. This also means that "yes" may not be the best answer for us. I often hear praises that God answered prayers, but what they're saying is that God has said yes. This isn't the only answer, nor should it be.

True, God can and often does say yes. But God can and often does say no. "God, let this woman be the one I marry, the job I get, the house I want!" Years later, one may be glad God said no. Sometimes it may feel like a no but may simply be a not yet. Remember that Abraham had to wait 25 years for Isaac to be born. God also may answer with something else. No, not this house (which has a problem you don't know about) but this one that will sell better. God knows, and as a good Father we can trust His answers.

God always answers prayers. Some we know, some we don't, some we won't for a while or maybe ever, but He always does. This week, thank God for His answers in advance, thank Him for answering even as you ask and pray, knowing that God's answer, whatever it may be, is the best one.
