Several years ago, John Lu and Angela Hu moved here from Baton Rouge, LA. with young son, Matthew. John had been baptized into Christ, so when the family moved to Corvallis for John's grad. school, many of you welcomed them with furniture and other household necessities.

Angela joined the Life Group we were hosting at our house. Eventually, Pam began reading the Bible with Angela and functioning as Mom to Angela whose actual Mom lived in Shanghai. She was "Auntie" to Matthew. A Wednesday night Thanksgiving meal together included Shrimp with the shell still on—which surprised some Americans. "The shrimp sure is crunchy."

I joined the Bible study with our Chinese friend. As the day approached for the family to move to Minnesota I planned the final Bible study. To our amazement, when Pam and I arrived to meet Angela she told us "I will be baptized." And so she was, less than a week before the family moved away. Since that time, Angela and Pam have spoken on the phone frequently.

The following Facebook post by Angela suggests that Circle Church of Christ truly has positive far-reaching effects. "Halloween night, couple of boys went out for trick or treat. One of the boys brought UNICEF donation box along. He was so patient and waited at the end of the line until other kids got their candies. Then he would go up and ask for donations. At the end of the night when they were walking home, he was very happy with a full box of money even though he had only half basket of candies. Here is a dialogue between his mom and him on the way home. Boy: I think God is everywhere.

Mom: why? Boy: He is in the wind, in the air.

And he is in people's hearts. Mom: Why?

Boy: Because people are so generous by giving money to the poor. He went home and took a \$10 bill out of his piggy bank and put it in the UNICEF box.

And yes, this boy is Matthew. Wow, he's growing up!!"
