Gregg's Good News

ZELMA "IRENE" STRAWN August 28, 1922-December 1, 2013

My Mom went home to be with her Lord on Sunday, December 1, following a stroke she suffered several weeks ago. Irene was born in her Grandmother's log cabin in Richland County, Montana.

The local school building at Mona, MT also served as the church building where Irene's father led the weekly Bible study. One summer, a traveling preacher and hymn writer named T. O. Chisholm came through the area. In her mid-teens, Irene was

baptized into Christ by Mr. Chisholm in the waters of Charley Creek. Irene was a faithful, involved member of the Church of Christ throughout her life, whether teaching children's Bible classes or serving people in numerous other ways. Her attitude of contentment through the twists and turns of life was shaped around the Bible verse, "I can do all things through Him who gives me strength."

Walt and Irene became members of the Corvallis Church of Christ in the early 1950's and were key members for decades. She was the church's book keeper for 38 years. For many of those years, the task included stretching the money to cover expenses at just the right time. She was a supporter of Campus Ministry: And was pleased to

help the church mature from its infancy into a stable congregation.

In her later years, Irene continued to be active with the Tuesday women's Bible study group until a stroke in November 2010 resulted in Irene moving to Park Place Assisted Living.

I appreciate all the sisters and brothers who helped Irene in these years since my Dad's death. Many have blessed Irene and me during this past 8 weeks of Hospice time.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday, December 10, at Circle Church of Christ at 1:00 in the afternoon. Viewing is scheduled for Monday, 1:00-5:00 p.m. at McHenry Funeral Home. Memorial offerings can be made to Benton Hospice or the University Christian Center c/o Circle Church of Christ.
