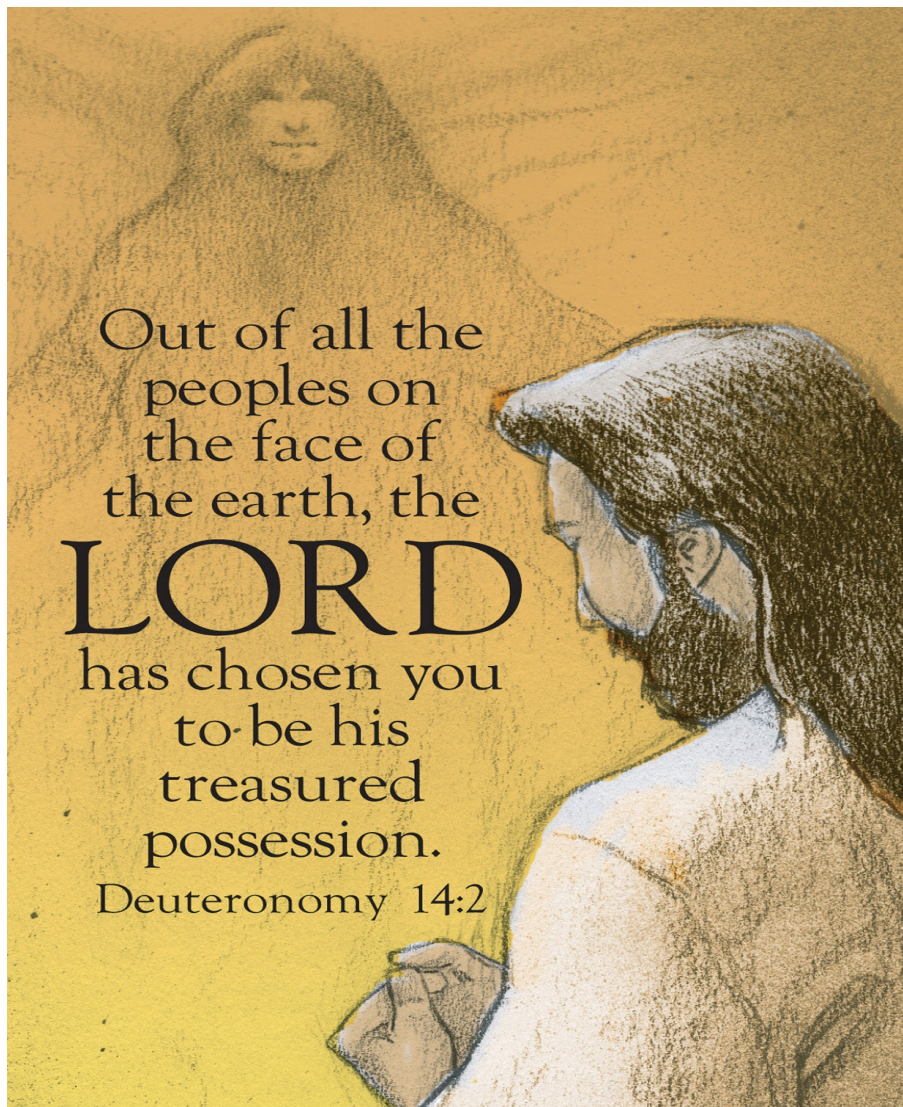

Some have taken the injunction not to be "showy" about fasting to such an extent that they are unwilling to even observe the practice. That was not Jesus' intent.

So, as we enter a season of seeking God to guide the congregation to additional leaders, Fast! In addition, we have several children who live with challenging health situations: we can fast and pray for them as well. Plus, many of us are aware of some personal challenge: a habit, a worry, a need. This is a good season to also bring that before God.
