# Gregg's Good News

This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> year that College classes for credit have been offered at the UCC. This year, courses in Old Testament and New Testament as well as Church History have been offered.

Tonight, you are invited to come and experience what those classes are like. I plan to teach material I presented during the New Testament Survey class. And I will be teaching in a fashion that is very similar to the way I have been teaching the CITE class.

This "Mini-Cite" class experience will begin tonight with an exploration of "Why Were The Gospels Written?" I will likely continue this CITE style teaching for about 4 weeks.

#### PRAYER THEMES for this week:

**Monday, March 17:** Pray that God would send His people to every corner of the world. Whether they are tourists, workers, vocational missionaries or full time missionaries—may Christians cover the world with the good news of the gospel.

**Tuesday, March 18:** Pray that God would empower the proclamation of his Word. The Bible is a powerful writing. Ask God to work through all who are proclaiming Him. Ask God to help people hear with their hearts.

Wednesday, March 19: Cry out to God to rescue people enslaved in spiritual darkness. From people who have never heard, to people enslaved by addictions or sinful habits, ask God to rescue people.

Thursday, March 20: God is always at work in His world, sustaining creation and accomplishing good works. Pray for all people to recognize the works of God and honor him for the goodness he displays over and over.

**Friday, March 21:** There are people in this world who influence others with the messages they communicate. Pray for Educators, people in the News Media, Politicians and Parents to communicate kingdom values.
