But more than that, the effort by our UCC group is a great thank you for the service resident members of Circle offer throughout the school year to members of the Campus Ministry.

Many of the campus ministries at OSU do not have attachment to a church. Instead, the ministry exists on campus but does not have an ongoing connection with

people from other age groups. The intergenerational connections that exist here are an important part of our campus ministry. Students have the opportunity to teach in Bible classes and see Christian life expressed at all phases of the life span. It is always good to experience and celebrate the unity of ages that we have.

Tomorrow, I leave for Searcy, Arkansas. For several years now, I have been part of a team that trains people to be vocational missionaries in Asian universities.

Once things get started on Tuesday afternoon, the schedule is jam packed through Sunday afternoon. Typically, the group gathers at 8:00 am and finishes in the evening around 8:00 pm or later. Most days, I have 3-4 segments that I lead.

I would appreciate your prayers. Two areas of focus are: 1) That I would be very effective in communicating for God. 2) That I would have good health and endurance. Typically, the combination of teaching, revising my notes/Power Points, and interacting with people leaves me so hyper that I struggle to get to sleep.

UPDATE related to last week's article. People in India did elect the man who does not have a good track record with religious tolerance. Continue to pray for the well being and boldness of Christians in that country.

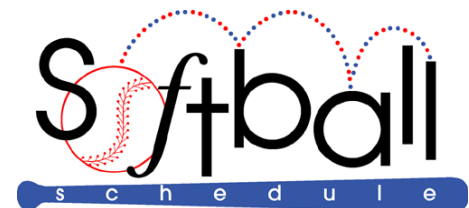
