Gregg's Good News

The news on Tuesday morning once again confronted us with the reality of a school shooting. Students at Reynolds High School in Troutdale should have been reveling in the laughter that goes along with the end of the school year. Instead, they were solemnly ushered out of the building—hands on heads—to make sure none of them were another potential threat.

I'll not enter the debate of gun ownership in the United States here. Actually, I'll tip my hand at the outset: I'm working from the premise that the problem under discussion is really deeper. I've listened to the arguments concerning whether guns should be outlawed or allowed in the United States. I've listened more closely and agreed as some have noted the poor job of caring for people with mental illness we provide in the United States. But my thoughts still go one step deeper.

If there is no God, there is no absolute right and wrong. If there is no God, then humans are not created with the intrinsic worth implied by creation in the image of God. If there is no God, then other people are merely a compilation of organic compounds and electrical impulses of no greater worth or import than a computer one discards when it is broken. If there is no God. there is no force outside oneself to cry to when life is unjust or another person does a despicable deed. If there is no God, I am the ultimate definer of what is right and

wrong. So if I feel like ending the life of a classmate when my rage exceeds the level of my self-control, what could be wrong with acting on my feelings?

The problem before us is too complex to analyze in this short writing. But I believe that an increasingly godless society is at least part of the answer to this violence question.

(This particular shooter was reportedly a member of a Mormon gathering. Some would suggest that proves my premise wrong. But here's the reality: Even "church kids" can be more shaped by their surroundings than by Christian thought.)

And that's why we can't stop making disciples of Lord Jesus.
