Gregg's Good News

I was driving back from the hospital this afternoon when a white car headed in the opposite direction passed me at a high rate of speed. Glancing over, I detected an elderly woman's white hair above the steering wheel and her fixed-gaze eyes below the top curve of the wheel. "Wow, she's really going fast," I thought.

It reminded me of an occurrence a couple days ago. Stopped at a light near the Aquatic Center, I waited as the signal for me turned green. Just before the light changed, to my left, I heard the sound of an engine revving high. Fortunately, I waited to enter the

intersection, because the large pick-up from the left accelerated through well after the light for me turned green.

"Why is everyone in such a hurry?"
"What is so important that you need to put your life and mine at risk?" "Is one minute worth the potential problems?"

But then my thoughts turned in an absolutely unexpected direction. "Why is it so much easier to notice other people's failings than to tend to my own?"

I can catch myself mistakenly driving that section of Walnut between Highland and 9th marked 25 MPH a little too fast. And seeing a light change yellow when I'm too close to the intersection forces me to snap-decide if I should stop or keep rolling.

My gut says, "That gal was driving too fast on purpose." "And the other driver had plenty of space to stop rather than stomp the accelerator." Those insights are probably true. But the fact remains: As a man who wants to increasingly have the heart, mind and actions of Jesus—I need to be primarily intent about my own life choices.

"You, therefore, have no excuse, you who pass judgment on someone else, for at whatever point you judge the other, you are condemning yourself, because you who pass judgment do the same things." (Rom. 2:1)


