Gregg's Good News

Last Sunday, I reiterated the slogan "Prepare to meet your God," various times during the sermon. Afterward, **Don Patton** was discussing with me the reality of uncertainty. No one really knows when life is going to end or when Jesus will return to initiate the final judgment. But it is easy to live as if the unexpected will never happen to "me."

As I was falling, I came to the realization that I was not going to be able to prevent myself from encountering the concrete. In a sense of slow motion, I watched my left little finger bend backwards some 90 degrees beyond the place it should typically stretch to. An inner voice acknowledged, "This is not good." 2 broken bones in my finger and hand agreed.

3 seconds before, everything went on as usual. There was no reason to assume that would change. But that momentary stumble led to drastic changes to the week as I anticipated and had planned it. Ice, Dr. visits, X-rays, and typing with 1 hand once again.

"Prepare to meet the concrete" was the slogan for my week. But the parable points to the greater truth: "Prepare to meet your God." The unexpected event that never possibly could happen . . . sometimes does.
