Gregg's Good News

The Community Christmas Sing-A-Long event is now less than 2 weeks away. It is set for Saturday. December 6 at 7:00 pm. Join us for Christmas Sing-A-Long practice today at 4:30 pm.

I've been reading through the Bible slowly. I'm not on the one year plan, so this morning I came to I Kings 7. It led me to consider the beauty of every Christian man or woman.

I Kings 7 offers a description of the incredible bronze work done by Huram of Tyre for the temple of the Lord. The craftsman created numerous elaborate items.

I Kings describes these in detail. It is obvious these creations were decorated with utterly eye-catching engravings and hammered work. Yet I was struck by the fact that these objects were not only incredibly beautiful, they were also objects that served a purpose. The striking bronze objects were actively used in the worship of the Lord.

Now my thoughts time travel ahead to the New Testament. At our time, the temple of the Living God is no longer a building in Jerusalem filled with beautiful bronze implements used in worship. The temple of the Lord is now constructed of diverse Christians who are "built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit." (Eph. 2:22)

In the Jerusalem temple, bronze items were beautiful as well as purposeful. When you look around this morning at a temple built out of brothers and sisters, stop for a moment and be awestruck. Everyone is beautiful who is built to accomplish the purpose and worship of God.

To teenagers upset that their bodies don't look like the air-brushed models in fashion magazines, to the divorced person who questions their worth, to anyone wondering how they look-the best bronze in that old temple doesn't shine as brightly with the glow of God as you do.
