
#### PLEASE FILL OUT A FELLOWSHIP CARD

If you are considering taking a CITE class at UCC this next term, I recommend that you just sign up. This past term I had the privilege of taking my second CITE class, The Story of the New Testament. Even though I have studied the New Testament a lot, I learned so much that has helped me grow in my faith and has made me more confident to teach Jesus to those who don't know him yet.

This next term CITE is offering two courses:

- 1) Christian Family by Shawn Jones: I had Dr. Jones for my first class and I highly recommend him as a teacher. His years of teaching at the college level and the pulpit has helped him to apply Biblical truths to daily life. These Biblical truths can have a positive impact on your family.
