Gregg's Good News

Monday afternoon, the #5 bus was especially busy. Students back in town following the holiday mixed with younger teens heading for home after the school day. In addition, witness the typical mix of older and disabled people who lack the luxury of driving themselves.

In some cities, there would have been grumbling as the wheelchair ramp descended for the woman with the black walker to duck walk to street level. Especially since the woman with the red walker next took her time making her way up that same ramp. The rest of us simply stood—knowing the parade would not be rushed. Except two teen girls, who whispered behind the back of the black walker woman. Were they saying ugly things? One could assume that about them.

Five teen girls sought seats together. Phones flashed photos and the latest Facebook updates between them. It was laughter, elbowing, light hearted youth on display.

But then red walker woman realized that her folded up conveyance had managed to roll its way under her bus seat. She tried, but there was no way her back was going to allow a bend so far that she could recapture her own wheeled necessity.

One of the original two teen girls observed the calamity, and without being asked, crawled on her knees

across the aisle with hours of foot traffic grime on it, to manhandle the red walker out of its trap. With the twisted machine returned to its reasonable fold, she placed the handles back in its owner's hands.

Red walker woman viewed that as an opportunity to talk to people—people that might respond to her in a way her 4 silent walls at home never did. And for a few moments, two teen girls were as respectful, attentive and conversant as if the gray-haired interrupter had been their own prized Grandmother.

For a moment, the light shined in the darkness. And God and I were left to smile.
