# Gregg's Good News

A block or so south of the church building, a 2 story apartment complex is being built. It has a very large footprint. But most notable is the position and effect of the new construction.

The area that is currently being developed is a large lot. But for decades, only the back portion of the lot had a building on it. That building still remains. It's a one story collection of apartments that all have doors and windows facing to the West.

The new construction is just to the West of the old apartments and quite near. The new construction towers over the old. Suddenly, sunlight will be blocked from the old building most of the time. That is especially rugged at this short daylight season of the year.

I recently walked by the new construction and started chatting with one of the neighbors. Shortly into the conversation, she voiced the concern, "Oh, it's going to be so dark for those people in the back." And I realized that it wasn't just me that carried that sense.

I think there is something about being human that makes us like the light. Rom. 13:12 states "The night is nearly over; the day is almost here." In this context, it's the return of Jesus being likened to sunrise. A sunrise that is ever nearer. What should we do in light of this? "Let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light."

That intrigues me. Even though it is still night time until Jesus returns, we are called to live as though his dawn is already present. So even if you live in an old apartment on the back side of the lot. And it seems like the sun is shaded most of the time. You can choose to be a bright spot anyway.
