Gregg's Good News

Last year we set aside a week for congregational fasting and prayer. Our emphasis was prayer for children who were facing various health issues. I want to invite all of us to engage in another season of prayer and fasting during this coming week.

I suggest a focus on the spiritual health of the upcoming generations. As I get a little older, my focus on seeing the generations younger than me embrace the faith and continue reaching towards church health becomes ever stronger. Obviously, our prayers will move many directions, for instance physical health for the children still needing healing, but I'm excited to see what a common focus on spiritual health for our youth will reveal in the future.

Fasting can take many forms. You may decide to miss a meal each day. You may decide to forgo lunch for a day. You may fast from media or video games. The point is to set something aside that will remind you to set God at the forefront.

In years past, it seemed that we read Jesus words in Matt. 6:16-18 and heard the emphasis to not make fasting a showy thing. That

was right. But we missed the very first phrase: "When you fast." So, I hope you will join together in prayer and fasting, not because we are out to impress anyone, but because it's just appropriate for disciples of Jesus to do.
