# Gregg's Good News

In the Gospel of John, Jesus offers an unexpected definition of eternal life. "Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent." (John 17:3)

"Eternal Life." We tend to emphasize the length of life the saved anticipate with God. In the words of Buzz Lightyear of the movie Toy Story, "To infinity and beyond." Without question, eternity or "infinity plus" is a length of time that transcends my human understanding.

On the other hand, it is easier to sense the implications of life vs. death. Whether for one day or a hundred, the prospect of dwelling in a hell where God is absent is a future I have no interest in. That is death indeed. In contrast, every moment of living intimacy with God is a prize I joyfully pursue both today and for the future.

As I combine the thoughts, I begin to realize that whether I am thinking about the present or the future: If God is not present with me, I am walking dead. And every moment of life spent with an intimate awareness/knowledge of God is experiencing life.

Yet I can't leave my consideration of the verse without acknowledging the context of Jesus' statement. Jesus is praying to the Father on the eve of his death by crucifixion. At a moment when the longevity of Jesus' security with God could be at the forefront, he identifies for us a truth that doesn't wait until physical death to become pertinent. Eternal life starts now: at the time you become a Christian. You step out of being one of the walking dead and begin walking the life of the resurrected Christ. It is life of a whole new quality that begins in the here and now. It is "eternal" life. Life inspired, shaped and sustained by no one less than God the Spirit himself.

Some have critiqued Christianity as little more than a delusional drug. They say Christians place hope in a future "fairyland" because they are too weak to endure or change the present.

Jesus' vision is starkly different. We know God now. So we live to make the world increasingly the kingdom of God without losing joy over the still unclaimed territory.
