Gregg's Good News

Part of the adventure of preaching is staying attuned to the Holy Spirit even after the words have gone onto the page. Last Sunday morning, as we sang and prayed together, an insight dawned on me that made its way into the sermon.

It has been decades since my own children were born. Last Saturday, my baby Granddaughter was born. Perhaps at the moment of becoming a new parent my

attention was utterly fixated on the well-being of the baby and things to do. When I was one step distant, it was easier to be immersed in the wonder. Sunday morning a flash of insight came.

I've always known that the act of baptism is a creation from the genius of God. Sunday, I discovered that the metaphor "born again" also stems from the genius of God.

Saturday evening, I touched a newborn. Over the hours, I was struck by the abject purity of a new born. I also marveled at the incredible number of possibilities that were open to this child. The vistas of opportunity seem virtually endless.

Sunday morning, I emphasized the "born again" metaphor near the end of my sermon. Imagine, grown people can return to the state of a

newborn. As innocent and pure as the perfection of Christ Jesus. Freed from the chains of guilt and defeat and death that Satan has applied, vistas of opportunity—new life—abound.

Witnessing the "new birth" of Alycia and Daylen after preaching, I was lifted up by their strong confessions of faith. This time, I got to witness the moment of delivery as two people rose up from the baptismal waters to new life. And when it was hug time, I touched a newborn.
