

Have you ever had one of those days when you just felt over-whelmed? You've taken your body to work yet one more time, but the lingering illness makes your mind feel like a November fog that just won't burn off. You're trying to stay motivated to tackle the "to do" list, but your eyes want to check the clock once again to see if you're any closer to heading home.

You tried to respond to events outside your control so that tax time wouldn't be difficult, but now you realize you owe thousands by April 15. It's not the first time you've owed something, but the slack in the budget that usually was there went down the drain last month with the unexpected plumbing problem. Oh, and the larger house payment due to an insufficient escrow account. Did I mention the changes in insurance?

You've tried to figure out that person who continues to catch you by surprise. It ought to be easy to get along, but you can't figure out what chemical reaction creates an explosion each time you have to collaborate.
