I point people to the website because the Internet is an increasingly common way for people to get information. Our website has an excellent video pointing to some of the unique aspects of this church—notably our desire to be welcoming. Guests can also find information about times we assemble and the basic beliefs we share. If you know someone who is looking to do a Bible study so that s/he will know how to become a Christian, that is also available. And for those who are curious about the church staff, they can find brief biographical sketches.

But the website is also a great resource for church members. The monthly "Schedule of Assembly Assignments" is posted so you can know in advance if you have special responsibilities for Sunday. A bulletin is also available for those who prefer to read the news before they arrive on Sunday.

Sometimes, people want to hear a sermon again. Or they want to catch up on an earlier sermon from a series that they missed. It is very easy to listen online.


A calendar of events is easy to access. And there are links to both the UCC website and the Circle Facebook page.
