Gregg's Good News

A man is currently in ICU due to an apparent drug overdose. That event happens all too often across the United States. For the most part, as sad as it is, it would prompt minimal recognition from the media.

But this case is different. The man in ICU is Lamar Odom. ESPN commentator Scott Van Pelt invited watchers to acknowledge his distinguished 14-season NBA career, his titles with the Los Angeles Lakers and his 2011 Sixth Man of the Year Award.

Van Pelt criticized people who remembered Odom primarily as a reality TV star from a stint on "Keeping Up With The Kardashians." (Do you know anyone who watches that show?)

The point being made was that Lamar Odom was a celebrity worthy of his acclaim rather than a celebrity whose acclaim was based on no significant achievement.

My thinking goes in a different direction: Why are Americans at a place that intrigue with celebrities, essentially to the point of worship, is so prevalent? Are we at a better place with higher interest in seeing celebrities than silent citizens who serve?

I remember a Bible study with a young woman who was considering becoming a Christian. She took a giant step towards Jesus as she realized he often reminded people not to tell about the wonderful miracle he had just performed.

Jesus could have been an instant celebrity. He chose to be a servant. Is it time for a new reality show? "Keeping Up With The Christians." The circle of people around you are already watching.
