When I **challenged** the congregation 4 weeks ago to stretch and **give 5-5-5** (\$5,000 for orphans, \$5,000 for Circle and 5 food items) on "Sacrifice Sunday," I didn't know what to expect. I only knew that I felt a prompt from God to set some goals.

Thank you to everyone for reaching deeply to make a difference. At last count, we gave

\$ 7108.04 that will be used for **Orphans** in various corners of the world. It takes approximately \$100 a month for an orphan's support. In other words, we gave enough to support 5 orphans for a year and a 6th child for nearly a year. \$ 6024.84 was given to continue our own efforts at world

changing. Dozens and dozens of food items were brought that will be passed on in our Thanksgiving and Christmas food boxes. 20 full shoeboxes for "Operation Christmas Child" were returned. These too will be sent to children around the world.

You have heard me use the following words to begin setting our vision: "Changing the World by Communicating Christ: From Corvallis to the Continents." You and I may never know all the consequences of good deeds done while we are on earth. But I know that storing up treasures in heaven is a very good thing to do. And based on what I do know about how the combination of good works and gospel words have brought many people to faith, I'd be utterly shocked if our efforts combined with the work of other Christians does not result in several people being saved.
