Isaiah 6:9 says, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." Jesus is the Prince of Peace. He brings peace. When Jesus is born, the angels proclaim, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!" (Luke 2:14). God brings peace through Jesus Christ. Jesus even tells us that he gives us peace. "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you.
