## Gregg's Good News

Recently, an acquaintance spoke of a plan for the Sunday evening gathering at his former church. He had tried to initiate the plan, but push back from attenders was high. They said, "We're afraid it would make us have to change things." The plan was a simple one: Reading through the Bible together.
